



1. All Head coaches are expected to establish an open line of communication with athletes, parents, coaches, athletic staff and administration about any matter that involves the athletic program.
2. Any communication generated by an athlete or a parent must begin with the head coach. After the initial meeting with either, if necessary and if requested the Athletic Director can join this initial discussion.
3. All players must have an open line of communication with their coaches. A player should always feel they can speak to you about anything.
4. Assistant coaches must take his/her concerns to the head coach of their sport.
(If the matter involves two programs, the head coaches must first discuss the matter).
5. All head coaches must take his/her concerns to the Athletic Director. (If any player, Parents, or Assistant coaches approaches the Athletic Director, Asst. Athletic Director or the Athletic Business Manager, they will be referred immediately to the Head Coach).
6. The Athletic Director, Asst. Athletic Director and Business Manager will communicate with the Administration.
7. The designated administrator will communicate with the Principal. (If any Player, Parent, Assistant Coach or Head Coach takes any concerns to the administration they will be referred immediately to the Athletic Director).
